



MAIDSTONE RCMP REPORT

For the dates of: February 10, 2026 – February 24, 2026, Maidstone RCMP responded to 81 calls for service, some of which include:

17 provincial traffic offences

CALLS FOR SERVICE:

- February 10th – Members responded to a domestic assault in the RM of Britannia near Sandy Beach. Caller was assaulted by their partner who left them on the side of the road. Members from Maidstone and Onion Lake Detachments responded. As a result of investigation, an adult male from Lloydminster SK has been charged and will appear in court at a later date.
- February 10th – Members received a report of elderly male in RM of Britannia being defrauded of \$12,000 via bitcoin.
- February 11th – Members received a harassment complaint involving an ex romantic partner. Investigation showed no grounds for a charge at this time.
- February 12th – Members received a report of youth in the RM of Britannia playing with fireworks in an unsafe and unsupervised manner. Parents and youth spoken with.
- February 12th – Members received a theft complaint from an oil field site in the RM of Britannia. One large propane tank was tipped over and another stolen. There are no leads or suspects at this time.
- February 13th – Members received a report of break & enter in the RM of Britannia. Investigation showed this to be a family dispute and caller requested no charges be laid.
- February 14th – Members responded to a call for assistance in the RM of Wilton. A motorist became lost and found themselves locked into a secure compound at a commercial property. RM of Wilton Police assisted in freeing the driver and their vehicle.
- February 14th – Members assisted with a harassment investigation occurring in Langley BC by speaking with subject of complaint in the Town of Lashburn. This matter has been resolved.
- February 15th – Members received complaint of vehicle window being smashed in Town of Marshall. There are no leads or suspects at this time.
- February 15th – Members responded to a mental health complaint in the Britannia RM. A female youth was being transported to hospital by family for treatment and began assaulting people in the vehicle. Members mediated the situation and family brought the youth to hospital.
- February 15th – Members received a report of break & enter in the RM of Britannia. Investigation showed this to be a family dispute and caller requested no charges be laid.
- February 16th – Members responded to report of a deceased male in the Town of Maidstone. Maidstone RCMP assisted the Saskatchewan's Coroner Office with the investigation who determined the death to be natural causes.
- February 16th – Members received report of theft of copper wire from an oil field site in the RM of Britannia. There are no leads or suspects at this time.
- February 16th – Members assisted Lloydminster RCMP with a mental health investigation. A male in distress was located in the RM of Britannia and brought to hospital for treatment.
- February 17th – Members responded to a report of a person not dressed for the weather walking along 16Hwy in RM of Eldon. Extensive patrols made with nobody located and no additional calls received.
- February 18th – Members responded to assist Britannia Fire with a structure fire in the RM of Britannia.
- February 18th – Members and Child Family Services responded to a mental health call involving a youth in the RM of Wilton. Members spoke with the youth and parent finding no need for police intervention. Matter being handled by CFS.
- February 19th – Members responded to report of a suspicious vehicle in the RM of Wilton. As members arrived on scene a tow truck arrived on scene that had been arranged by the driver. Nothing criminal.
- February 19th – Members received a report of theft of utilities. Members assisted SaskPower with an investigation in the Village of Waseca. File is still under investigation.
- February 19th – Members received a report of damage to fuel tanks at a business in the RM of Eldon
- February 20th – Members received a request for a welfare check on an adult female in the Town of Maidstone. Family had not heard from her in several days and were concerned. The female was located and members had no concern for her safety.

TRAFFIC SAFETY

- February 13th – Members received a report of a hit & run at a business in the Town of Maidstone. File is still under investigation.
- February 14th – Members responded to a single vehicle collision in the RM of Britannia. Driver found to be sober and properly licensed and insured. Vehicle towed out and driver arranged for transportation.
- On February 17th – Members on patrol located an abandoned vehicle in the RM of Britannia. The vehicle was not stolen, was across the fog line, and the RO contacted. Due to an ongoing snow-storm, the vehicle was towed by the Department of Highways as it interfered with their snow removal operations.
- February 20th – Members on patrol attempted to stop a vehicle that fled in the RM of Eldon. A description of the vehicle and plate was obtained and the vehicle was later located in Onion Lake. An adult male was arrested and as a result of investigation was charged with several offences including possession of stolen property and flight. The accused was held to appear in court.
- February 21st – Members on patrol located a vehicle driving erratically in the Town of Maidstone. The adult male driver refused to provide a roadside breath sample and was subsequently arrested and charged with refusing to provide a breath sample and impaired operation.
- February 21st – Members on patrol located a vehicle in the ditch in RM of Wilton. Investigation showed that the driver had fallen asleep. Vehicle towed and driver picked up by family.

WANTED

Brad MILLARD (50) of Maidstone, Saskatchewan is wanted for two counts of mischief under \$5000-damage to property and failure to appear in court.

Shawn WHITNEY (21) of Waseca, Saskatchewan is wanted for theft under \$5000-theft of gas and failure to appear for court.

Stuart MARTELL, 36, of Onion Lake, Saskatchewan is wanted for unsafe storage of firearms, carrying a concealed weapon, unauthorized possession of a firearm/prohibited weapon, possession of firearm/weapon/device ammunition in motor vehicle, adult possession of restricted firearm/prohibited weapon with ammo without licence/registration, fail to comply with release order condition and failure to appear in court.

Jeffrey MCLEAN (41) of Lloydminster, Saskatchewan is wanted for operation while prohibited, possession of property obtained by crime less than or equal to \$5000, pursuit involved – flight from peace officer, dangerous operation of motor vehicle, possession of property obtained by crime less than or equal \$5000, and operation while prohibited.

Justin NOETH (35) of Paradise Hill Saskatchewan is wanted for failing to comply with a probation order and failure to appear in court.

Stephen REID (44) of Lloydminster is wanted for assault and assault with a weapon.

Charlene LAMEMAN (45) of Lloydminster, Saskatchewan is wanted for mischief under \$5000 and carrying a concealed weapon.

Brednar SNAKESKIN (33) of Turtleford, Saskatchewan is wanted for 4 counts of failing to comply with his probation order.
