



MAIDSTONE RCMP REPORT

For the dates of: June 18, 2026 – July 30, 2026, Maidstone RCMP responded to 486 calls for service, some of which included:

8 -Mental Health Act

CALLS FOR SERVICE:

- **June 18** - Report of a white car pulled over 2km East of Maidstone a shirtless man with blue shorts/boxers yelling at a female. Members performed a patrol. No assault took place.
- **June 19** - Daughter walked away from their campsite at Silver Lake in RM of Eldon. Complainant worried about her daughter's mental state due to recent events. Daughter had been located at her boyfriend's house with responsible adult.
- **June 20** – Members responded to complaint of a burnt F150 in the RM of Wilton. Vehicle found to be stolen from Lloydminster.
- **June 20** – Complainant driving a U-Haul to pick up her belongings in Maidstone. Her ex allegedly is threatening to harm her and new boyfriend. Request members attend in case ex does attend. Members attended. Subject not there.
- **June 20** - Intoxicated woman at a restaurant in Maidstone and won't leave when asked and is yelling at patrons. Woman located, arrested, and held at Maidstone Detachment.
- **June 22** – Caller reported a well-dressed person in blue blazer and long skirt walking on the shoulder of 16 Hwy in RM of Wilton. Not in distress but suspicious. Patrols made but did not locate.
- **June 23** – Caller reports 15 horses loose near the 16 Hwy in RM of Eldon. Member attended and helped wrangle horses back into the pen they came loose from.
- **June 23** – Complainant in RM of Britannia advised that someone from Stars called and said they were delivering 2026 F150 truck and a cheque for \$95,000 because she purchased a calender and some magazines from them. Complainant sent an e-transfer for \$499.82. Bank stopped e-transfer. No money lost.
- **June 23** – Caller reported grand-daughter left home and wasn't telling her where she went. Grand-daughter located at mother's home in Lloydminster.
- **June 25** – Caller reported male and female screaming at each other in a truck outside of her home in Lashburn. Vehicle started driving away. Patrol made but did not locate.
- **June 25** - Mischief to SaskPower property in RM of Eldon. Damage occurred on June 19th. Unknown persons attempted to rip down the transformers. Nothing stolen from location.
- **June 26** – Reports of a female on Hwy 16 in RM of Paynton in distress members responded with EMS who took female to Lloydminster Hospital for minor injuries.
- **June 26** - Complainant from Maidstone reporting \$11,000 taken from their bank account and credit cards. Still under investigation.
- **June 27** – Call to a residence in Maidstone for report of female overdosing. EMS attended to treat female. Female safe and on scene and treated upon arrival. Female declined additional medical treatment and was transported to a safe location.
- **June 27** – Caller reported an unidentified male walking and stumbling on 16 Hwy in RM of Wilton. Members attended, located intoxicated male, and drove them to a safe location.
- **June 29** - Collision on 16Hwy in RM of Eldon. Passenger vehicle drove into rear of a commercial truck. No serious injuries reported. Dashcam from commercial truck show passenger vehicle drifted from outside lane to inner and collided.
- **June 30** – Report of suspicious vehicle on 303 Hwy in RM of Britannia. Members attended and vehicle is stolen from Saskatoon.
- **July 1** – CN Police report a male walking on the tracks in RM of Eldon. Multiple patrols and not located. CN Police updated.
- **July 2** – Report of person in mental health distress in Waseca. Members attended and brought person to Battleford Hospital for mental health care.
- **July 3** – Caller reported copper wire casings left on lease road in the RM of Wilton. No cameras no suspects. Wanted Members to be aware, as there is issues with oil sites being targeted.

- **July 3** – Driver reported wind caused their trailer to roll onto its' side on 16 Hwy while being towed. No injuries reported.
- **July 4** – Report of an unknown male possibly doing drugs in the public bathroom at Sandy Beach. Members attended but unable to locate suspect.
- **July 5** – Report of a hitchhiker on 16 Hwy in RM of Eldon. Members attended but were unable to locate the Hitchhiker.
- **July 6** – Caller in RM of Britannia reports he was woken up by a truck alarm. Caller went outside and seen unknown person get into a vehicle and leave headed towards Lloydminster.
- **July 6** – Caller in RM of Wilton report her late fathers truck was stolen from their field. Vehicle previously found abandoned on a lease site and recovered.
- **July 6** – Caller in Town of Paynton reported receiving the text message that she had a traffic court date. Caller advised it was fraud and to block and not send any money.
- **July 6** – Complainant reported delivering packages in Maidstone, when two dogs exited the residence and attacked him. Serious bites to arms and srcapes on leg. Property rep is aware. Complainant and victim updated.
- **July 7** - Members responded to call of single vehicle collision near Paynton SK. Vehicle had driven into ditch to avoid a deer. Members attended with Paynton Fire Rescue. No injuries reported.
- **July 8** – Call at Sandy Beach reporting a female with an aggressive dog possibly consuming drugs in the bathroom. Members attend and patrol but unable to locate suspect.
- **July 9** – Report of break and enter at business in Wilton RM. Tools painted pink stolen out of locked trailer on property. Video reviewed and no plate obtainable from subject vehicle. Still under investigation.
- **July 9** – Call of off-road vehicle collision in RM of Wilton. Youth attempted to jump onto a moving side-by-side but was unsuccessful and unintentionally ran over. Youth transported to hospital with serious but non life-threatening injuries.
- **July 10** – Members executed public safety search warrant at a residence in the RM of Britannia to remove firearms. One charge of unsafe storage of a firearm was laid against an adult male from the RM of Britannia.
- **July 11** – Report of 750 litres diesel fuel stolen from equipment in RM of Britannia.
- **July 11** – Call of a female found laying in ditch along road in RM of Wilton. Members attended and found woman had fight with other vehicle occupants who left her on roadway. Female uncooperative with investigation.
- **July 11** –Report of woman yelling at vehicles on 16 Hwy in RM of Wilton. Member attended, located female, and drove her to a safe location.
- **July 12** – Multiple calls of a male assaulting a female at Sandy Beach. Members attended, and arrested intoxicated male leaving scene. Adult male from Lloydminster SK charged with assault.
- **July 12** – Male driver fled from traffic stop with Wilton Police in the Wilton RM before later coming to a stop on a grid road. Adult male from Ft Saskatchewan charged with flight from police and held for court on this and unrelated arrest warrants.
- **July 13** – Caller from Lashburn SK reported finding homemade explosive device while cleaning. RCMP Explosive Disposal Unit attended to retrieve the device. No injuries or property damage occurred. File is still under investigation.
- **July 14** – Caller from Lloydminster SK reported her mother had left for Neilburg SK and had not arrived or been heard from. Members assisted in search with subject later being found by family alive and well.
- **July 15** – Caller request a wellbeing check on her friend in RM of Wilton as she had not heard from him. Subject was located at home safe, just did not want contact with caller and had not been returning any of her communication.
- **July 16** – Member attempted to stop vehicle 144MXJ in RM of Eldon but vehicle did not stop. Vehicle later found pumping up tire and male driver fled a second time. Vehicle found to be stolen from Saskatoon.
- **July 17** – Member conducting proactive patrols in Lashburn noted a trailer with no plate parked on roadway. Member spoke with male working on truck near trailer. Investigation showed trailer to be stolen and the vehicle unregistered. Both vehicles seized.
- **July 18** – Report of female sitting on side of road beating on road with fist and screaming. Member attended and located female who said she was hitchhiking to Lloydminster and was swatting at mosquitos. Female driven to a safe location.

- **July 19** – Caller from Marshall report that someone overnight somebody through her vehicle and into her garage. Believed opened the garage with opener in vehicle. Nothing taken besides opener. No surveillance. No witnesses.
- **July 20** – Caller from Marshall reports his wallet stolen overnight from his unlocked truck. No surveillance or witnesses.
- **July 22** – Report of a single vehicle roll over on 17 Hwy in RM of Britannia. Driver failed to make turn causing vehicle to go off road. Passenger transported to hospital with minor injuries. Driver of vehicle stole a truck from good Samaritan and fled. Vehicle and driver located in Onion Lake SK. Driver arrested and charged with multiple offences and held for court.
- **July 22** – Caller from Lashburn reported her 15-year-old daughter had received messages from an adult male believing it was somebody they knew. Male turned out to be unknown and communication ceased. Nothing criminal found in conversation.
- **July 23** – Call from Kids Help Phone reporting contact with youth in RM of Eldon saying they have pills and thinking of overdosing on them. Members attended to speak with youth. Youth transported to hospital for mental health care.
- **July 24** – Caller requested wellbeing check on friend in RM of Britannia as friend has medical conditions and hasn't spoken with in a week. Subject located alive and well.
- **July 25** – Caller requested check on their mother in RM of Wilton as mother said she was suicidal. Members attended and spoke with subject who said she was not suicidal just stated that to daughter so she would leave her alone. No safety concerns and subject lives with another family member.
- **July 26** – Caller from Marshall reports receiving a text message to pay a speeding ticket and clicked on the link because they had recently received a speeding ticket. Caller did not provide any personal information or send money. Caller told to report potential fraud to their bank and have phone checked for viruses.
- **July 26** – Caller in Marshall reports girlfriend came over, they argued, she pushed him, and left. No injuries reported. Parties separated to prevent further incidents. Caller declined to participate in investigation.
- **July 28** – Report of break and enter of a garage in RM of Britannia. Small items and hand tools totaling \$2000 were stolen.
- **July 29** – Report of male laying in the road in RM of Wilton. EMS on scene but male refusing to move from roadway. Members attended and male medically cleared and driven to a safe location.
- **July 29** – Report of collision in RM of Eldon. Caller struck a deer, airbags deployed, vehicle not drivable. Members attended, no injuries reported and vehicle towed.
