



MAIDSTONE RCMP REPORT

For the dates of: July 30, 2026 – August 12, 2026, Maidstone RCMP responded to 193 calls for service, some of which included.

1 - Mental Health Act
0 - Child, Youth and Family Services Act
5 - 911 Act
5 - Assault

CALLS FOR SERVICE:

- July 30 – Officers received a call from the RM of Paynton of a suspicious vehicle driving up people's driveways. Vehicle gone on arrival.
- July 30 – RCMP received a call of a large amount of wiring ripped out of a site over the week in RM of Britannia. No surveillance and tracks washed away by rain.
- July 30 – RCMP attended the Paynton cemetery after receiving a call of a suspicious knife with powder on it. Nobody had touched the powder so no medical concerns. Knife disposed of.
- July 30 – In the RM of Britannia RCMP received a report of damage to oilfield equipment on a lease site.
- July 30 – A complaint of a truck cutting off a semi and driving aggressively on highway 16 near Paynton. Patrols made and vehicle located. No grounds for a charge.
- July 30 – A resident of Marshall reporting credit card fraud. Report sent to CAFC.
- July 31 – RCMP received a call of 15-20 cows on highway 16 just east of Maidstone. Cows were herded off and gone on arrival.
- On July 31 – Members received a report of a vehicle throwing something at another vehicle then brake checking caller on highway 16 near Paynton. RCMP waited roadside but vehicle not located.
- August 1 – RCMP received a noise complaint in the town of Marshall. Members attended and found a dog howling. Owner will get it resolved.
- July 31 – A vehicle was hit on Main Street in Maidstone resulting in rear end damage. No camera and no suspects.
- August 1 - Maidstone RCMP received a Bolo out of Battleford RCMP of an erratic driver on highway 16. Vehicle located and driver admitted to falling asleep due to long drive. Warning given and driver left road.
- August 1 – A call of a 2-vehicle collision on highway 303. Damage to both vehicles. Ticket issued and a tow called for as one vehicle was not driveable.
- August 1 – Members were called to do a wellbeing check on residents in Lashburn. RCMP attended.
- August 1 – A resident of Paynton reported being assaulted by an unknown person. Caller was punched after confronting the strangers and they drove away. Patrols conducted and nobody located. No injuries reported.
- August 1 – Members attended a residence in the RM of Britannia for an unwanted person. Suspect arrested and later released.
- August 1 – Maidstone RCMP were called to Sandy Beach for a dispute. Members attended and a woman and child were relocated by family.
- August 2 – RCMP were called to an assault behind Maidstone bar. Charges laid.
- August 2 – A wellbeing check was requested. Multiple locations checked and individual eventually located.
- August 2 – Alarm at business in Lashburn. Nothing stolen.
- August 2 – Members attended an unwanted person at Sandy Beach. Involved parties became uncooperative. As a result of investigation one male was charged.
- August 2 – Break and enter at Krambury Estates. Damage to property. Still under investigation.
- August 2 – Members received a call that a stolen F150 was at Alcurve store and stolen credit card were used. Vehicle later recovered in Lloydminster.
- August 2 – RCMP received a call of youths found at a break and enter in Lashburn. Members investigated and reached agreement with property owner for restitution.
- August 3 – A female was on 16Hwy near Lashburn stating that she had been kicked out of a vehicle and attacked. Female taken by EMS to the Lloydminster hospital. Still under investigation.
- August 3 – A call was made to the RCMP of a person shooting fireworks from a truck on 16Hwy near

Lashburn. No damage to vehicle and member was unable to locate suspect vehicle.

- August 1 – A suspicious vehicle in Lashburn was reported to RCMP. Plates were ran and found not to be stolen. Truck was no longer in Lashburn when patrols were made.
- August 3 – A black Nissan Sentra was called in going 150 km/hr and passing unsafely near Sandy Beach on highway 17. Maidstone RCMP on in position to intercept so BOLO'd to Lloydminster.
- August 3 – Police received a 911 hangup pinging in Sandy Beach. Members attended Sandy Beach and made patrols on HWY 17. Members spoke with park staff. No concerns brought up. No one in distress. No concerns for safety.
- Augst 3 – RCMP received a request for a wellbeing on a male last seen in Paynton. Police located the individual safe.
- August 3 – A resident of Waseca called to report that her neighbour has a security camera pointed towards her property that beeps when she leaves. No answer on call back.
- August 3 – Member received a call of a red Bronco swerving ditch to left lane, when com passed the male driver had his head laid back and appeared to be sleeping behind the wheel. While on the line, the driver turned into Paynton, caller continued on. Cut Knife BOLO'd patrol negative for vehicle.
- August 3 - iPhone crash notification in the RM of Wilton. Members attended and found a single vehicle rollover. Driver/occupants had fled prior to members arrival. PDS attended and drone deployed. It is believed driver was picked up. SOTI's issued to RO via mail.
- August 4 – Caller in RM Wilton reported an unknown people came into his site and stole a side by side as well as multiple blowers and car batteries.
- August 4 - A 54-year-old male reporting he believes he mistakenly drove away from the Tempo in Maidstone without paying for his fuel. The male drove back to pay. Member confirmed with Tempo that he did drive off however they had not reported it to police. Caller returned and settled his bill.
- August 4 - A 47-year-old female called the ambulance twice over the span of two hours complaining of back pain at that her red civic broke down. Ambulance could not locate and advised RCMP an hour after the last call. Extensive patrol did not locate female or the car. Female was seen around time of original call near Lashburn by Members.
- August 5 - A passerby reported person laying on the side of Highway 17 in RM Britannia. A female was located uninjured and provided ride to safe location.
- August 5 – Report of flagger being hit in construction zone in RM Britannia. Flagger transported to hospital by EMS with non-life-threatening injuries. Tickets to be issued to vehicle driver.
- August 5 - Caller reported an erratic driver on highway 16 in RM Wilton. Purple Jeep SUV. Unknown plate. Patrols made but did not locate vehicle.
- August 5 – A female caller reported that on 17 highway in RM Britannia occupants of a grey Jeep Cherokee throwing a vodka bottle out of the window. Patrols made, vehicle not located.
- August 5 - A resident in the RM of Wilton reported an uncontrollable youth family member. On-going issue. Members attempting to help family in get in touch with appropriate services.
- August 6 - Residential alarm in RM Wilton. Single hit to kitchen glass break. No answer on site. Member able to speak with keyholder who advised false alarm.
- August 6 - Two vehicle collision at Highway 16 and Highway 21 North. Members attended. A Lloydminster resident failed to stop at the intersection and hit a Toyota Highlander occupied by six people. EMS transported multiple people to hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. Tickets issued.
- August 6 – Resident of Lone Rock reported harassing behavior from a known male. Resident has spoken with the male and wanted the interaction documented.
- August 6 - Fraud reported by resident of RM of Wilton. Phishing scam where account information was provided to scammers. Do not believe any money was lost and bank is working on changing accounts.
- August 7 - Caller reported aggressive driver following her on 16 highway in RM of Paynton. Member intercepted vehicle. Nothing criminal noted.
- August 7 - Maidstone Fire responded to vehicle fire on Hwy 16 near Waseca, 2021 Ford Bronco fully burned. Believed electrical issues. Owner on scene. Provided file number for SGI. Not suspicious.
- August 8 - Lashburn resident reporting his tenants have been given notice to vacate property sold. Occupants have not left and the new owners are ready to move in within a week. Owner directed to Office of Residential Tenancies. Member phoned resident who advised will be out by Sunday evening. Owner updated.
- August 8 – A Marshall resident reported his zero-turn John Deere lawn mower was stolen from his vacant property east of Marshall on August 3, 2026. Footage provided. Still under investigation.
- August 9 - Greenstreet resident reported a boat that was coming and going late into the evening. Caller can hear it and it's keeping her awake. Members attended and all was quiet.
- August 9 – Caller from Marshall called 911 because she was new to Canada and lost. On callback member learned that there was no emergency and that Caller had called a taxi for a ride.

- August 9 – Theft of electrical wire and a radiator stolen from a lease site in RM of Eldon. Items stolen sometime in the last month.
- August 10 - Break and enter to seacans at business in the RM of Wilton. Member attended. Locks had been pried open. Approximately three thousand dollars of Milwaukee tools stolen. No witnesses or surveillance.
- August 10 - Rollover on Highway 16 in RM of Wilton. SUV went into the center median and rolled onto the oncoming lane. The driver was deceased on scene. Still under investigation.
- August 10 - Report of two vehicle collision in RM of Britannia. Member attended and found semi travelling south did not stop at stop sign, was hit by truck going west. Ticket issued.
- August 11 – 911 call from stranded driver in RM of Eldon. Members attended to ensure safety. Driver and occupant declined to leave vehicle due to possibility of vandalism.
- August 11 - A driver reported a white and red dog causing traffic hazard on Highway 16 in RM of Paynton. Looked like it had a collar on. Dog was gone on arrival once members arrived.
- August 11 –A caller reported a break-in to a service rig in the RM of Wilton that occurred four days ago. Batteries and 800L of fuel stolen.
- August 11 – Report of a minor vehicle collision on 16Hwy in RM of Eldon. Drivers stopped to exchange information and argument became heated with a knife being brandished. Female from Lloydminster charged with assault with a weapon and released for future court date.
- August 11 - A caller from Lashburn reported that his ex-girlfriend took a lot of his belongings with her and some of his roommate’s things when moved out. Members mediated and items returned.
- August 12 – Construction material reported stolen from a worksite in RM of Eldon.
- August 12 - A caller in RM Brtiannia reported seeing a female dropped off by a blue SUV on Highway 17 and began walking towards Lloydminster. Caller was worried about female’s safety. Members made patrols but were unable to locate female.

TRAFFIC SAFETY

- July 31 – Driver speeding down highway 17 north of Lloydminster, tested positive for THC and suspended for 3 days and vehicle was impounded for 3 days.
- August 2 – Maidstone Traffic issued a ticket for driving over 35km over the speed limit. A ticket for \$742 was issued.
- August 12 - A driver traveling Eastbound on Highway 16 near Maidstone, SK stopped for a driver's licence, registration and sobriety check. Unstamped tobacco observed in plain view in the centre console. Driver arrested for possession unstamped tobacco. Search resulted in three cartons and four loose packs of unstamped tobacco. Tobacco seized for disposal. Verbal warning provided.
