



MAIDSTONE RCMP REPORT

For the dates of: August 12th – August 26th, 2026, Maidstone RCMP responded to 138 calls for service, some of which include:

47 Provincial Traffic Offences
4 Vehicle Collisions
22 Property Offences

CALLS FOR SERVICE:

- August 8 – Report of road signs and stands stolen from construction site in RM of Eldon.
- August 12 – Caller in RM of Britannia reported seeing a woman exiting a vehicle on 17Hwy and the vehicle drove away. Caller was concerned for her safety. Patrols made but unable to locate. Female later identified and spoken with, no injuries and no concerns.
- August 13 – Parent in Maidstone reported that her children were biking and were followed briefly by a white vehicle. No contact made between driver and children. Unknown driver and unknown plate.
- August 13 – 911 Call with no voice contact made, only yelling heard. Phone tracked back to a residence in North Battleford. Occupants spoken with and no concerns found.
- August 13 – Report of an assault between parent and adult child in Lashburn. Members attended and mediated situation. No charges laid.
- August 14 – Caller reported that he believed his girlfriend was drinking and driving with their child in the vehicle on 17Hwy in RM of Britannia. Patrols made but unable to locate vehicle.
- August 14 – Report from a business in Maidstone of unknown persons parked overnight in a parking lot in a U-Haul truck. The unknown persons appear to be living in the truck. Members attended, confirmed nothing criminal, and requested persons to move along.
- August 14 – Report of a landlord-tenant dispute in Marshall. Members mediated.
- August 15 – Caller reported that they had been left on the side of the highway in Paynton RM by their friend. Members patrolled area but were unable to locate caller.
- August 15 – Several calls from involved parties reporting the end of the relationship and issues surrounding child custody and personal property. Members attended and mediated.
- August 16 – Caller in RM Wilton reported his daughter (teen) hitting him and wanted a restraining order. Speaking with caller, they became uncooperative with investigation and with members.
- August 16 – Caller from Paynton reporting unknown persons in a U-Haul parked in their driveway. Members attended, confirmed nothing criminal occurred, and U-Haul moved at request of property owner.
- August 17 – 911 Hang-up in RM Britannia with unknown people yelling on phone, no information provided. Members patrolled area and spoke with owner of phone. All denied calling 911 or needing police.
- August 17 – Report of a deceased male in RM Briannia. Members attended with SK Coroner. Death non-suspicious in nature and result of medical condition.
- August 17 – Report of an unknown female walking around the Paynton Town Office. Members attended and female not found.
- August 17 – Report of several properties in Town of Paynton spraypainted with orange spray paint. No leads or suspects.
- August 17 – Report of road signs stolen from near Birch Lake in RM Paynton.
- August 17 – Legacy Fire report house fire in RM Wilton. Members attended to assist. Fire caused by negligence non-criminal in nature.
- August 17 – Nolan LAPLANTE of Calgary AB arrested in Town of Waseca on behalf of Calgary City Police for several outstanding warrants. Mr LAPLANTE held for court in Lloydminster SK before being transferred back to Alberta to deal with his matters.
- August 17 – Report of suspicious male walking in field near 16Hwy in RM Eldon. Members spoke with male who had pulled over for a break and lost his dog. Members used drone to locate then reunite dog and owner 6hrs after dog went missing.
- August 18 – Report of stolen AB license plate BNX7778 in RM Wilton
- August 18 – Report of 12 yearling heifers missing from property in RM Eldon. Owner uncertain if stolen or escaped. Referral made to RCMP Livestock Investigator

- August 18 – Report from Britannia Fire of vehicle on fire on range road in RM Britannia. Members attend to assist. Vehicle stolen previous night in Lloydminster SK. All evidence destroyed by fire.
- August 18 – Residential security alarm in RM Paynton. Members attend and speak with homeowner who stated no emergency, system has been acting up.
- August 18 – Report of stolen truck in RM Britannia. White GMC Sierra SK plate 649LUA stolen sometime overnight. Vehicle still missing.
- August 18 – Report in Town of Maidstone of fraudulent call. 20-year-old female tricked into providing personal information.
- August 18 – Request from Child & Family Services to assist in Town of Lashburn. Members attended, nothing criminal occurring. Child removed from residence by CFS to stay with other parent.
- August 18 – Caller in RM of Eldon report being victim of telephone fraud in which they have lost \$10,000. Investigation ongoing.
- August 18 – Report of motorcyclist parked along 16Hwy in RM Eldon holding a firearm. Members attended. Motorcyclist carrying bike chain and tools attempting to repair motorcycle. No firearm located.
- August 19 – Report of deceased male in Town of Paynton. Members attended with SK Coroner. Death non-suspicious in nature and result of medical condition.
- August 19 – Members responded to residential alarm in RM of Paynton. Members attended and spoke with property owner who stated no emergency and system has been acting up.
- August 19 – Members responded to residential alarm in RM of Wilton. RM Wilton Police in area responded and spoke with property owner. Alarm set off by accident.
- August 20 – Caller reported their truck stolen from property in RM Britannia. White Ford F350 dually with flat deck bearing AB plate CVD8956 stolen. Vehicle still missing.
- August 20 – Report of a male laying on side of the highway with liquor bottle visible in hand. Members attended with EMS to evaluate male. Male uninjured and taken into custody for their own safety to be released when sober.
- August 21 – Report from taxi driver in RM Britannia who had a passenger refusing to pay fair and making threats. Members attended and mediated situation. Matter resolved peacefully.
- August 21 – Report of a loose cow along township road in RM Britannia. Members attended, located cow owner, and had cow returned to field
- August 21 – Report of a male attempting to hitchhike on 16Hwy in RM Britannia that appeared intoxicated. Members attended and confirmed male was intoxicated. Male taken into custody to their own safety then released once sober.
- August 21 – Report of a female driver in medical distress on 16Hwy in RM Eldon. Members attended with EMS and Maidstone Fire. Female unable to be resuscitated. Death non-suspicious in nature and result of medical condition.
- August 21 – Report of a female walking on tracks near Lloydminster in RM Wilton. Another person with the female pulled her from the track before the train stuck her. Train emergency stopped. Maidstone and Lloydminster members attended but female and other person not located.
- August 21 – Anonymous caller in RM Britannia reported that while at a lease site “smoking a joint” they found a rolled-up carpet and suspected there was a body inside because that’s what they do in the movies. Members attended and found nothing criminal.
- August 22 – Report of suspicious vehicle parked near an old bridge in RM Wilton. RM Wilton Police and RCMP attended. Vehicle not located.
- August 22 – RM Wilton Police located suspicious vehicle parked on dead-end road in RM Wilton. Driver Nathaniel TURNER found to be wanted for outstanding warrants from Kindersley SK. Mr TURNER held for court in Lloydminster SK before being transferred back to AB to deal with his matters.
- August 22 – Britannia Fire report a tractor fire near 17Hwy in RM Britannia. Members attended and fire non-suspicious.
- August 23 – Members responded to panic alarm at a business in Town of Lashburn. Members met with business owner and checked property. No emergency found and alarm deemed false.
- August 23 – Members patrolling 16Hwy in RM Wilton located an intoxicated male walking near highway. Male stated he was walking from a wedding after getting into an argument. Male driven to a safe location.
- August 23 – Report missing adult male who left a residence in RM Wilton after a verbal argument. Members conducted search and investigation. Male returned home late on August 24th safe.
- August 24 – Female in Town of Lashburn called 911 to report spouse yelling and scaring her and their children. Members attend and found all was calm. No immediate criminal or safety concerns noted. Male driven to a safe location. Investigation ongoing.

- August 24 – Caller in RM Wilton reported almost hitting a male walking on 16Hwy. Members attended and located an intoxicated male. Male arrested and held in custody until sober.
- August 25 – Report of abandoned vehicle in Town of Marshall. Members attended and nothing criminal noted with vehicle. Owner contacted who stated had broken down and arranging for tow.

TRAFFIC SAFETY

- August 14 – Report of an erratic semi on 16Hwy in RM of Paynton. Description of trailer provided but no plate. Patrols made but unable to locate vehicle.
- August 15 – Multiple calls of elderly male driver going wrong way on 16Hwy in RM Wilton. Members in area made patrols but unable to locate vehicle.
- August 16 – Caller reported they picked up four people in RM Wilton after driver was drunk and rolled their car. Several people uncooperative with investigation. Tickets issued for failure to report accident.
- August 17 – Report of an abandoned vehicle in RM Britannia. Members attended and vehicle not reported stolen. Owner contacted who stated vehicle had broken down and was being removed.
- August 19 – Report of semi-vehicle striking a moose in RM Eldon. Members attended, confirmed nothing criminal, assisted with scene control and arranging tow.
- August 20 – Members responded to report of a single vehicle roll-over in RM of Britannia. Driver had minor injuries and went to hospital for evaluation. Nothing criminal in nature observed. Accident believed to be caused by distracted driver.
- August 22 – Caller reported their boyfriend driving intoxicated on 17Hwy in RM Britannia. Members patrolled area but unable to locate vehicle.
- August 22 – Members patrolling 17Hwy in RM Britannia stopped a vehicle to check for registration, licensed driver, and sobriety of driver. Open cannabis visible in vehicle. Driver arrested for possession of cannabis in vehicle, vehicle searched, and warning issued.
- August 23 – Members conducting vehicle stop in RM Eldon when an uninvolved vehicle approached, preformed a U-turn, then began driving wrong way on the highway. Members engaged the wrong-way driver who eventually stopped in Town of Waseca. Intoxicated male driver taken into custody and charged with dangerous driving, flight, and failure to provide breath sample.
