Attention: Home Owners/Private Sewage Works Contractors/Installers

Requirements to Obtain Health Approval for Private Sewage Works

The Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations requires that no plumbing system or private sewage works is to be installed, except under authority of a permit. In addition no sewage or sewage effluent is to be discharged, except with the written approval of the local authority (health).

Section 20 of The Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations reads:

- 20(1) No sewage or sewage effluent is to be discharged:
 - (a) into surface water, except with the written approval of the local authority;
 - (b) into the subsoil within 10 metres of any dwelling;
 - (c) onto the ground surface within 30 metres of any residence;
 - (d) onto the ground surface or into the subsoil;
 - (i) within the limits of any city, town, village, organized hamlet, or approved subdivision containing at least two parcels, or within one kilometre of its boundary, except with the written approval of the local authority or the minister; or
 - (ii) within 15 metres of a drilled well properly constructed, or within 30 metres of any other well or water supply used for domestic purposes; or
 - (e) into a storm sewer.
- 20(2) Except where approved pursuant to *The Environmental Management and Protection Act*, sewage in a shoreland development area must be disposed of in accordance with *The Shoreland Pollution Control Regulations*, 1976, being Saskatchewan Regulations 54/76.
- 20(3) Sewage from every building not connected to a communal sewage works must drain into a private sewage works.

The following are specific sections from *The Saskatchewan Plumbing & Drainage Regulations* with respect to permits, approvals and inspections:

<u>Section 5</u> requires all private sewage works to be installed under authority of a permit. This includes any extension, renovation or alteration of a private sewage works.

<u>Section 8</u> specifies who can apply and obtain a permit to install a private sewage works. Permits can be issued to bona fide sewage installers who are found to be qualified and/or the property owner.

<u>Section 10</u> requires that all private sewage works may be inspected and it shall not be covered over and/or put into use with out permission by the local health authority.

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<u>Section 25</u> requires that approval be obtained prior to installation for any private sewage works that include lagoons, absorption fields, above ground filters, jets, sewage holding tanks or any other works deemed a private sewage works.

To apply and obtain prior approval for a proposed private sewage works the following information must be provided to <u>Prairie North Health Region</u> so that the design of the system can be assessed to determine if it is designed according to requirements in *The Saskatchewan Onsite Wastewater Disposal Guide*.

- Plot plan showing location of house on property in relation to septic tank, disposal field, well and all property lines.
- Soil sample test results from an approved testing soils laboratory of soil from the area the private sewage works is to be installed.
- Type of private sewage works being proposed (pressure chambers, absorption field, type II mound and etc).
- Onsite information on ground water depth (If a well is already drilled the well driller's log would suffice or Saskatchewan Watershed can provide information on wells in the near vicinity).
- Amount of effluent that would be generated from the premise based on number of bedrooms.
- Design criteria to substantiate the size of the private sewage works. Please include the worksheet appendices for the type of private sewage works being proposed.
- Size of parcel of land private sewage works is being proposed on.
- Information to indicate how many other parcels of land are developed or proposed for development within a one mile radius.
- A completed Private Sewage Works Permit Application Form and Permit Fee.

The Saskatchewan Onsite Wastewater Disposal Guide which provides all the information needed to design a private sewage works, so that it meets health requirements can be accessed directly off of the Ministry of Health website at:

Note: Construction of a private sewage works is not to commence until such time as the design of the system has been reviewed and formally approved by a Public Health Officer employed with Prairie North Health Region.

It will take approximately one week to review and to make a decision on the design of the private sewage system provided all the above information has been submitted.
